



Social Media & Conduct Clause – British Agility

Participants, officials, volunteers, competitors and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner at all times, including on social media and other online platforms.

The use of the name British Agility, or any associated event, official, organiser or volunteer, in a derogatory, defamatory, abusive, misleading or disrespectful manner is strictly prohibited.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Posting comments, images, videos or messages that bring British Agility into disrepute
- Sharing private, confidential or sensitive information relating to British Agility, its officials, organisers, volunteers or participants
- Publishing allegations, complaints or disputes publicly rather than following British Agility's official procedures (via the official email address only.)
- Encouraging harassment, abuse or negative campaigns against British Agility or any individual connected with it

Any concerns, complaints or disputes must be raised directly and privately with British Agility through the appropriate official channels. Individuals are responsible for managing their own actions and conduct online.

Failure to comply with this clause may result in disciplinary action, which may include, but is not limited to:

- Being asked to leave the event immediately
- Revocation of current or future entries
- Refusal or decline of future entries to British Agility events

British Agility reserves the right to take such action at its sole discretion where conduct is deemed to breach this clause or damage the reputation, integrity or operation of British Agility.
